- SEE is for English and non-English speaking clients
- SEE caters for Youth as well as Mature Aged and Indigenous clients
- SEE is an approved outcome for Transition to Work (TTW) clients and can be an activity for ParentsNext clients and Disability Employment Services (DES) clients.
- SEE is a pathway to employment or further study
- SEE is a FREE program funded by the Australian Government
- SEE has both part time and full-time options and clients can start at any time
- SEE is flexible and classes are offered in your local area

SEE participation is worth 25 points per week towards a participant's monthly target, which is 100 points for most individuals. SEE can fulfill a participant's mutual obligation requirement.
